<u>Subject: Concerning Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)</u>

<u>Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006</u>

<u>Regarding the REACH list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) updated on 14 June 2023.</u>

To whom it may concern,

REACH is a chemical legislation that replaces large parts of the chemicals regulations that applied before June 1st, 2007 in the EU and Sweden. According to REACH, all the substances produced or imported to the EU in quantities of one tonne or more per year need to be registered at European Chemical agency (ECHA).

We hereby declare that Stena Stål is fully aware of REACH and our role and obligations according to it to register the substances covered by the legislation. To fulfil our obligation Stena Stål AB communicate with suppliers and customers related to REACH regulations. We check that our subcontractors (manufacturers) and suppliers fulfil their obligations and have registered the components in accordance with REACH.

- Stena Stål products fully comply with the related requirements European Union Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)
- Since Stena Stål do not manufacture or import chemical products into the EU, we are so-called downstream
 users. Meanwhile Stena Stål's further processing of the material (e.g. Cutting, Bending, Painting, Milling, and
 Welding) does not make the products are subjected to registration.
- Stena Stål confirms that products stocked by Stena Stål AB meet the requirement regarding REACH restricted 235 SVHC updated on 14 June 2023 by ECHA. We will continuously review the list of SVHC and when substances are added act accordingly in compliance with REACH regulations.
